### Open Play Rules of Play

1. Table stakes apply.
2. All bets will be in chips.
3. At the start of play, the dealer button is positioned to the right of the dealer. Blinds(s) start to the left of the button.
4. In limit games, there will be a maximum of three raises in any betting round. In No-Limit games the number of raises is unlimited in any betting round.
5. Players place their bets in front of them. Please do not co-mingle bets.
6. When betting stops, the dealer verifies the bets and announces “Pot Good” and moves the bets into the pot.
7. After the River Card is turned over and betting stops, the dealer pushes the pot to the player with the winning hand.
8. Once play has commenced, individual players must be escorted to open seats by a volunteer.
9. Players may only change tables by being escorted from one table to another by a volunteer.

**Subject to change.**

**Players who take individual seats or change tables without the volunteer escort may be removed from the Festival Center.**

Please note: Tipping dealers is expressly prohibited.
